Set B requirements

- Bachelor's degree or higher (or global equivalent)
- 36 months/3 years' experience leading and managing projects within the past eight years
- 35 hours of project management education/training or CAPM® certification (the PMI Authorized On-Demand PMP Exam Prep course can help fulfill this requirement)
